For me this emphasises the point of our Mission Trip to Romania. There were times, such as the night I returned from the visit to the homeless, a harrowing, heart-wrenching experience, where I faced a feeling of helplessness, where I felt I could never give enough to these poor, suffering people. But Kevin Hoy, founder of 'The Smiles Foundation' reminded me: 'You can't change the world for everyone, but you can change the world for one person', and I believe I, and all of us that went to Romania have made a big impact upon many people's lives there.
