The Smiles 400 Faith Club is about supporting the projects in Tileagd


'Eye-opening, challenging, awe-inspiring, admirable and over-whelming' are just some of the words and phrases this year's Educational Challenge team used to describe their experiences.

The team was made up of 13 excited teachers from the UK, plus the Educational Advisor, Stephen Woodward, and Cristina Popescu, Smiles Mission Organiser. Together we embarked on a 3-day trip to take part in the fifth Educational Challenge.



The programme included visits to the Tileagd Gypsy
Community and the children's homes, lesson observations
and the opportunity to engage in teaching and learning
activities with the children. The children enjoyed a wide
range of practical, creative activities in subjects such as
Art, Design Technology, Puppetry, PE and Mathematics.
The children had lots of fun and so did we. We also spent a
fabulous afternoon celebrating 'Children's Day' - beginning
with some of the groups making sandwiches with the team and ending

in fun and games galore in the basking sunshine.



Visits to the Barrage Community and the Homeless of Oradea brought a very real, heart-wrenching dimension to the experience. This served to provide an insight into reality of the situations where Smiles strives to improve the quality of life for the marginalised in society - and in some cases the homes of some of the children who attend the school. All of us were moved and inspired by this aspect of the Foundation's work.





A regular Educational Challenger said, 'It is always good to visit friends - and in the Tileagd community there are so many. The promotion and evidence of love, respect and trust make Tileagd an inspiring place to be. The vision for the future is walked and talked daily. My admiration for the team has risen again. Each time I return I hope to give a little of myself,

but know I receive so much in ideas and ideals. The challenges are evident and also it is clear that every visitor faces challenges. I feel honoured to be a small part of making a difference to the children here. The experience continues to make a difference to me.'

school has touched my heart, the teachers are an absolute inspiration. Their love and commitment, along with a structure that works, allows the children to feel safe and to develop.

Another team member commented, 'It is amazing how much has been done and is being done to improve the quality of life for such a small community, starting with the basics in education as well as health and well being. Having the chance to go on the Educational Challenge was extremely welcomed and I am so happy I did it.'
