- You don't need to be wealthy to make a Will or to leave a gift.
- If you have an existing Will but would like to leave a gift to The Smiles Foundation, you can do so by way of an addition to that Will—which is called a Codicil.
- If you have not yet made a Will then you should use the services of a Solicitor. Although there will be a fee for their services.
- There are two main ways to leave a gift to Smiles.
 Residuary Legacy: after taking care of your loved ones you can choose to leave a portion of what is left to Smiles.
 Pecuniary Legacy: you can specify a certain amount to Smiles.
- Inheritance Tax is not payable on gifts to Registered Charities
- In order to include the gift in your Will the solicitor will just need to know the Name, Address and Registered Charity Number as follows:
