### MISSIONS PILLAR

Missions is one substantial corner pillar that supports the entire work of God through Smiles. It covers strategic elements of long-standing projects that have been the backbone of Smiles for over 20-years. Now with new vision and motivation, the MISSIONS Pillar strives to be "salt & light" as we are commanded in **Matthew 5 v16**.



Most people around the world, know the Great Commission! How many are doing it? Sadly, not too many! "Around the world", most of the time, means around our house, on our street, in our city or neighbourhood, which for sure it includes, but in God's eyes - everything is important!

For the Missions Pillar, after the major changes we did at the beginning of 2021 on the main operating structure, things have settled reasonably well. Even though the circumstances we live in, this covid pandemic era, can change things from one day to the next (at least in Romania it can). In the Tileagd Nursery we started another academic year with 40 kids happy to be back. This year we have two age groups, and it seems to be working well, so far.

The Tileagd After-School supports about 10 kids going further in attending the state school to extend their education, which is good. We try to support, as we are able, but we have learned in the last 18 years of doing Education for the Gypsy Culture, that it requires ultimately, for the

interest and effort to come from them. We can reinforce the importance year after year, try everything to encourage, if not persuade them to continue, but ultimately, it must be their decision. If they decide and are committed, the education process will reap much greater rewards.

After such a difficult and often depressing time living with this pandemic, we had the great news in August of our first mission trip group this year! In fact, our first since December 2019. It was amazing to have a team back in the Mission Centre, working with us on projects every day.



It was really encouraging and totally recharged our batteries, especially mine! We have a few more arriving in October and then again in December. We are slowly but surely getting back in the swing of Mission Trips, and I couldn't be more thrilled to have our friends visiting and sharing the Work with us.

As the travel restrictions are steadily lifting it gives the opportunity for us all to go where we have dearly missed, and I know for many of you, that includes Romania. Being reminded just how special our Mission Teams are means we are even more desperate and praying for a magical bumper year in 2022. I truly pray you are making plans to come and to share the Work here in Romania. Everyone is waiting!



Before I finish, I want to remind you we have less and less days to Christmas! SOOOOOOO my favourite project S.O.S (Sack of Smiles) will take place this year and you can help me one of two ways – or both! I have lots of kids waiting to receive a gift and for me to see them smiling when we give a Sack of Smiles in December, is one of the greatest things! 

#### Container Challenge 2021

Collecting items, packing them into boxes and filling a container to go out to Romania has been an annual event for the Smiles supporters in Northern Ireland since 2009. Due to Covid however, the last container sent out was back in June 2019, and the absence has been greatly felt by Smiles in the intervening two years. So, there was great excitement and anticipation when Kevin announced the Container Challenge in his June newsletter — this was going to be a special container because all four countries in the UK were going to be involved.

Darren Charles brought a vanload of much needed items from Worthing via Cornwall, Cardiff and Leeds to the store in Ballymena, Northern Ireland and Jean Barclay organised a vanload of supplies from Dalmellington, Scotland to add to all the supplies collected throughout Northern Ireland over the summer. Smiles are indebted to McBurney Transport who have agreed to bring the container out to Cihei, a round trip of over 3,500 miles.

A wonderfully committed team of men and women who came with exactly the right spirit. Their desire was to serve – and serve they did in a

#### RESIDENTIAL PILLAR

Residential is a key-pillar of Smiles - demonstrating God's love and compassion for the elderly and disabled in our communities. Substantial facilities with trained and dedicated staff, enables Smiles to be a leader in the development of Residential Care in Romania. We rejoice at God's provision as stated in Isaiah 46 v4.









JFL is more than a centre for the elderly, it is a family, a place where people with life stories meet and spend their later years together, in terms of remembering the years of their past.

Every day of the week, our beneficiaries from JFL have some free time activities, such as: aerobics, film club, worship time, board games, reading club. In these activities they feel very well and with the wisdom of some people who have gone through life they relate to each of them. Currently at JFL we have 29 beneficiaries with different needs, hobbies and interests. We can say with a joyful heart that in July-August-September the Lord blessed us and we recorded an increase in the number of beneficiaries after the crisis caused by COVID-19 when there was a period of decline in numbers.

The Enterprise Pillar carries the responsibility of supporting the Work of God through Smiles as an honourable Business, doing God's Work in God's Way. 100% owned by the Smiles Foundation, ensures all profits are channelled into front-line ministry - wherever most needed with the other three supporting Pillars of Smiles. Inspired by **Matthew 25 v15-16**.





During the past months, the activities at the Glasshouse were focused more on preparation for the busy sales at the end of the year. In order to be ready for the autumn season, we have improved some of the production protocols, so that the workflow will



be better and faster. Not the least, as often the delivery period is quite demanding, we try to make sure the system for loading and sending the plants will function perfectly.

The Summer period, which is always a happy time in Romania, provided the opportunity for us to also enjoy other type of successes - Dani, our colleague who is in charge of a lot of the practical aspects of the work, got married in June! You see, talking about happy times...

Unfortunately, the impossibility to have you present here in Romania, as Mission Trip visitors, made the work at the glasshouse even more challenging and added another pressure to organise the work and get

everything in place for the respective dead lines. But we had some of our colleagues from other projects who were very happy to help and we organised some special staff-days in Arpasel, to make sure we kept up to speed!

Just for you to know, between October 2021 and April 2022 is basically the busiest season of the year - we need to plant, grow and sell about 750,000 flowers to our partners. We will supply plants, as in the past years, for Lidl and Kaufland and we still pursue the big Carrefour option. This is indeed huge and for a rather small team of people it is a lot of work, this is why organising the whole activity as well as possible is very important!

Hopefully there will be more possibilities for you to come over and maybe next time when you are here we can meet again and you'll be able to spend some time with us at the Sminro Glasshouse. We always appreciate the occasion! Thank you for being a supporter of Smiles and Sminro and let's hope soon we'll see each other again and we'll spend more time together!

Sometimes the needs at the glasshouse require extra work-forces. As we missed our beloved visitors, who are always so generous in helping out with everything that's necessary, our colleagues from other areas of Smiles come and help us! There's nothing better than a good team-building session with the bulbs involved!

We have seen some great things over the years which only God has made possible through His provision and blessings, and I am extremely grateful as I reflect on these past years with a Church, School & Nursery in Tileagd, a Church and Community rebuild in Rapa, a Residential Care Home in Salonta and an amazing Glasshouse in Arpasel – to name but a few and not forgetting the beautiful Dezna Outreach Centre – all of these projects focused on building His Kingdom and bringing Souls into His Eternal Glory.



You may have heard little snippets here and there about the new project being launched this month called **Sunset House**, **Cihei**. A state-of-the-art Facility providing residential Adult Care for the Elderly, Disabled and Vulnerable.
