

## Conferences in Dezna, as part of our Outreach Programme

Under the Outreach Pillar, we are and have always been concerned with providing opportunities for those interested to learn more. We believe every man and woman can be better at whatever they want to do, should they spend the time and energy to get there! Especially in the spiritual sense, when it is actually God himself who empowers!

Earlier in February, we organised the first conference for pastors and leaders, hosted at Dezna Outreach Centre, where we discussed the perspectives and needs of the Church in the XXI century. The invited speaker was a professor pastor with great experience and knowledge and the points he shared were really useful for those attending. We had with us younger and more experienced church workers from various places, who felt they wanted to have some good fellowship for a couple of days together and learn something useful in the same time!

There are two more conferences we have planned for this Spring, before the summer camps kick-in. One at the end of March, for women especially, and another one in April, specifically for Youth and their concerns. All great occasions to enjoy time with people who can share valuable experiences! We are sure about this because at the end of the first conference, we had a questionnaire for the participants and everybody was very happy and appreciative. The only discontent was that it didn't last long enough! At least one or two more days would have been appreciated! And that was despite the rain outside, which did not stop for a minute, so we could not even do our routine of going up on the mountain!...

So, please continue to pray for us and for the future activities at Dezna Outreach Centre, there are many exciting opportunities coming, which we want to benefit from, to spread the Gospel and to enable other people to do the same, being well equipped and guided! All for God's Glory!

## Activities and Programmes, Plans for what's next

Often times, we discuss, here between us, how many blessings we are given from God and how much He entrusts us to do the right thing about it, not only for our own purposes, but also for the work and Christian ministry. And everytime we get to the same conclusion: there is more to be done, more to be achieved, as God's grace is always renewing and provides more and more!

Looking at the past years, we moved more towards the spiritual concerns regarding the work with people, and we explained many times why is that. The social work is not forgotten, but we strongly believe our role is rather to assist people in getting their life changed for better, and in fact the only real way is to get them to Christ and allow Him to do the change.

That's why we have enlarged the team again, to include more people, with good experience both on the field, but also with the spiritual work. The purpose is to cover all areas of work. When it comes to talking with people, getting them to be receptive to our message, it is still important to provide for their immediate needs. So, we continued delivering food parcels, medicine and clothing to the families out there, but we try to spend more time exploring the deeper issues they might have, we pray with them, advise and encourage them into the right direction, in the spiritual aspects, but also assist in practical ways.

Programmes like Rapa Community or Homeless Container Village visits are, of course, still very much a permanent activity. We are meeting with the kids twice a week and with the people at the Night Shelter three times a week. In all our interactions with them, we talk, pray and teach them, in a way they can understand and relate to and might find to be useful to them.

Every Wednesday our team goes to our own Residential Centres and spends time with our residents. They are happy to receive us and they enjoy not only the fellowship we all have together, but also the individual discussions and prayers. We found this time to be very valuable and we are looking into increasing it.

We are anticipating a lot of other activities developing in the future months and years to come. We are considering even partnering with other people and organisations that are also involved in ministry, to get involved in other areas. Looking into what's possible, we are excited and we pray to receive the support, human and financial, to get to all of these. Through the 2023 Mission Trip season, which is near, we hope to be able to show you and get you involved a lot in all we do under the Outreach Pillar, and we are sure you'll enjoy it!

Please continue to pray for us and to support our Programmes, we believe they are part of God's plans for the Romanian people and we are grateful to be part of His work in this country. May God bless you and keep you well and safe!



# The Continuing Story of Sunset House, Cihei



Just about everyone in the Smiles Family or associated with us, will have heard of the vision and the hope we have for the newest Facility we are building in Romania, we call Sunset House, Cihei. This has been an active project now for over 18 months, and to avoid repeating myself, I strongly suggest if you are not familiar with the project thus far, catch up using the Gallery Update on the Smiles Website – [www.thesmilesfoundation.org](http://www.thesmilesfoundation.org) and go to the Sunset House Link, normally on the Homepage. Our previous newsletters can also be seen on the website – from the Homepage, go to the NEWS drop down box and select ‘Smiles Newsletters’.

For those who know the story to date, I am delighted to have the opportunity here to share the current situation with the project and detail a few of the issues to be prayerfully engaged with in the coming weeks and months.

After some delays experienced with the project, we recently agreed with the various Contractors involved, that the completion stage of the main construction would be rescheduled from May, to late June, early July 2023. But notwithstanding any further unexpected delays, especially now weather is less of a concern, we truly expect to have a finished structure by July.

Even while that main structure is being completed, a great deal of critical work is being undertaken on the interior of the building, such as Electrical, Plumbing, Fire Department requirements, Internet and Data installations, Plastering to name but a few.

We are also excited in anticipation of windows and doors currently in manufacture, to start being installed during April. The elevator, already contracted for manufacture in Spain, is scheduled to be installed during May. Likewise, the Hydrotherapy Pool should be installed no later than June 1<sup>st</sup>. With such a large facility, the process moves step by step through the building, so we expect by some point in May, certainly by June, rooms will be ready to start painting. There are 106 rooms of varying shapes and sizes, so painting will take some time!

Painting, second fix of Electrics and Plumbing, along with Landscaping and Gardens, will all be tasks we trust many of our Smiles Family will come to help with. From June 17<sup>th</sup>, we have Construction Specials starting and we seriously need your help, so check the website or call the Smiles Office.

The timing and order of events will of course be critically important, not to get the ‘cart before the horse’ and we have a carefully designed schedule of when each area of work is needed and completion dates, so the next stage can get started on time.

I am very excited to see the interior work begin, so please consider if you can join us to help with the challenge. Our many Mission Teams this year, who will assist all our regular projects, will also be given a chance to spend a day or two helping at Sunset House, but there are many coming to Romania to spend their entire stay, working next door to the Mission Centre, at Sunset House. What a great time of fellowship and positive achievement they will enjoy.

We are so overwhelmed, yet extremely thankful, with the generosity of so many supporting this project. To date, more than £1,459,000 (\$1,750,000) has been invested in Sunset House, Cihei.





Coming up in the weeks and months ahead will be the following commitments to meet:

Then looking ahead, other significant expense to prepare for is special installation for the Sensory Room, quoted at £31,504 (\$37,805) for just equipment and the interior finishing and furnishing, budgeted at £200,000 (\$240,000) but that won't be fully needed for another 6 months or more – but all is designed to see the entire facility completed and ready for occupancy by May 1<sup>st</sup> 2024.

I know that seems a long way away, but with right around £1million (\$1.2million) to raise, we are probably going to need every day, to be achieving something special for the Lord, through Sunset House, Cihei.

Please continue to pray about how you can help with a Gift, a Fundraising Event, a Loan to help with the cash-flow time pressure. All sorts of way you can be part of seeing this Dream become a Reality.

At the beginning of this year, we planned for each month various activities with our beneficiaries. This time we wanted to organize activities on specific days like Day of the Elderly, International Read Together Day, various Spring holidays, Poetry Day, or World Earth Day. Plenty opportunities!

In February, in addition to the usual activities and programmes with the residents, we also organised a "reading together" session. Gathered in the big living room at the centre, we discussed with our beneficiaries about the importance of reading, well-known authors, new books to read and, of course, we spent some hours reading from a book, as per the occasion.

The book in discussion was **Unstoppable** by author Nick Vujicic. The author, despite being born without arms and legs, could be a great inspiration for each one of us, he managed to overcome all the hardships of life, focusing on the certainty that he was created for a unique and specific purpose, that his life has value and that God is present and He can use us, no matter the circumstances. By reading excerpts of this book, we wanted our friends to be encouraged through the difficult situations caused by illness and infirmity, to strengthen their faith and so become unstoppable when life's difficulties arise.

Dora is a young woman who came to our centre earlier this year. She is the youngest of all the residents, she is only 36 years old.

For the first time, she celebrated her birthday away from home, but she is definitely not alone. Not only does she have the other residents close by, as everybody likes her, but she still has her family coming to see her, they do show their love and so Dora feels she is the luckiest person in the whole world.

Her father was always close to her, and despite the severe disability Dora presents, she was never neglected or abandoned. For all her life, family took good care of her, but now it is harder and harder, as her father is ageing and brothers and sisters have their own families to take care of.

Dora's mother died a long time ago. With herself being in need of support, she couldn't have helped much - and yet, Dora sometimes recalls moments they had together. The rest of the family was supportive though. And now, as this major change happened, our team will continue to offer the support and assistance she needs.

We were all very pleasantly surprised to see how much Dora enjoys our gatherings for worship on Sundays and Wednesdays. She also prays with loud voice, every time! Of course, because of her condition, she has sometimes



moments when she's noisy and acts awkwardly, but she remembers what was being preached and she is worshiping together with the others as well. We were very intrigued by this, but equally thankful to God, because this is showing that even a severe disability cannot take away that deep and profound touch of Christ!

We think of Dora as precious in God's eyes! We are not to judge people in any way, rather we are called to love, assist and support them, to help them understand and then to confirm to them every day that God sees value in each one of them, just as in every single human being and He loves us all so much!





# ENTERPRISE PILLAR

**19 March Sunday 7.25 am!** - My alarm rings with the text "Finish the newsletter today and send it immediately to Adi!"

It's a lovely sunny day with 12 degrees Celsius already, so I take my coffee and my laptop and go out on the terrace. The beautiful sky takes my eyes from my messy garden, realizing that spending so much time in the greenhouse steals my time and my interest to make my garden more presentable. Well, its time will come for sure at some point!

And I thought "Simo, this newsletter is not about you, it's about Smiles Enterprise Pillar - SMINRO!" So then I thought, let me tell you a few things about how our past six months passed.



As you all know, time flies when you are having fun, or in our case, when you are extremely busy! Winter season is the busiest time of the year for us and once again, I could see God's presence in this season's success.

Starting from December and all the way to February, all our 550,000 hyacinth bulbs, 60,000 daffodil bulbs, 40,000 primroses, 10,000 tulips were delivered and invoiced to our customers, securing over £142,000 (over \$170,000) sales within a 3-month timespan. For our staff, that meant hundreds of hours spent in the greenhouse, working very hard, but it was all worth it.

There is no bigger satisfaction than seeing the greenhouse empty, but empty only to be full again, very soon! Empty for only 2 weeks – from 10th March, all the spring crops will kick-in : 35,000 dianthus, 62,000 geraniums, over 150,000 bedding plants and so on.

So, after a week of cleaning, disinfecting and resting, we start all over again. This is a needed process, in order to make sure the next production will be safe and only high quality plants will be delivered.

A production season is finished now and soon another one will start. It's a good time to count our blessings, to acknowledge once again God's favour upon us. He gives us strength, physically and mentally, to deliver in time and to fulfill all of our commercial obligations to clients, opening doors and more opportunities for the next season.

God rewards hard work and this fact (because it's no longer only an immaterial belief) keeps me motivated and strong in challenging times. This is what I tell my colleagues all the time and I am happy to see their commitment and desire to do their best. Please continue praying for us and for the Glasshouse to stay successful!

In the past months, we launched a new and demanding challenge, to all those who are willing to give a hand, in a practical way, to make Sunset House Cihei that beautiful place we imagine it can become!

So, we launched the **Construction Specials**, which will start on June 17th and will be available for every week, for those interested in visiting Romania to help with their practical skills. We need everybody!

From Plumbers to Electricians, no matter what you can help with, your contribution will be very much appreciated and we are looking forward to hearing about your interest. Professional or not, you are welcome to join!
